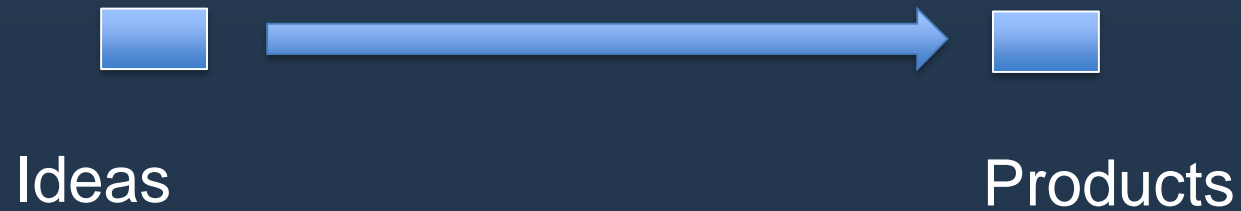

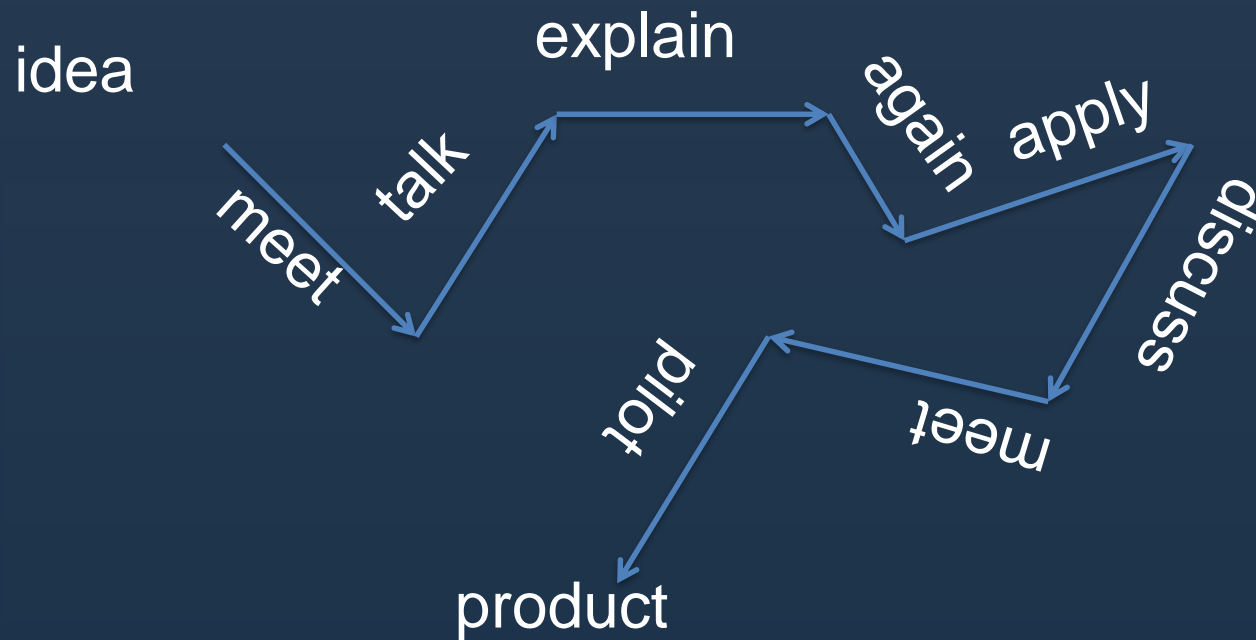

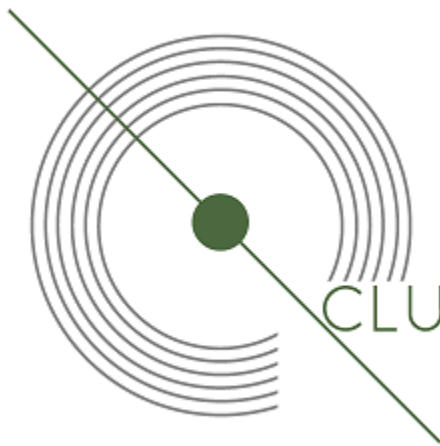

- ✓ The grass is greener on the other side



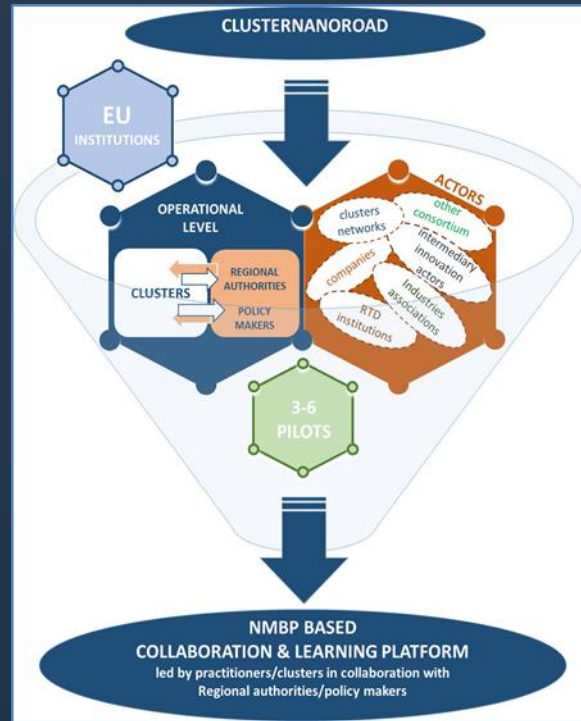
